This xeric garden offers an opportunity for handson learning and provides a template that can be easily replicated in a homeowner's garden.

The Xeric Garden Club of Albuquerque is a non-profit organization and a member of the Council of Albuquerque Garden Clubs, which owns and operates the Albuquerque Garden Center at 10120 Lomas Blvd NE. Albuquerque NM 87112. The Council maintains demonstration gardens in the adjacent Los Altos Gardens, including the Xeric Wildlife Habitat developed and maintained by the Xeric Garden Club.

The Xeric Garden Club meets once a month in January, February, March, September, October and November, on the first or second Saturday. These monthly programs feature xeric garden topics and include speakers, slide presentations, garden tours and demonstrations.
